

Attachment for individuals residing in California.

This Attachment for individuals residing in California (hereinafter referred to as the 'CCPA Notice') supplements the Privacy Policy and applies only to California residents. This CCPA Notice is in compliance with the California Consumer Privacy Act as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (CCPA), and all terms defined in the CCPA have the same meaning when used in this CCPA Attachment.

We collect 'Personal Information' as defined in the CCPA from the following categories of sources:

1. Directly from you: For example, when you make a purchase or fill out forms related to the products you acquire from us or the services you use.
2. Indirectly from you: For example, through interactions on our websites.
3. From other companies within our Group of Companies.
4. From our business partners and service providers.

How we share Personal Information:

We disclose personal information to our service providers, contractors, and third parties for business purposes in accordance with written agreements or contracts.

Your Rights and Choices under CCPA

CCPA provides California residents with certain rights regarding their Personal Information. This section outlines your CCPA rights and explains how to exercise them.

- **Access to Specific CCPA Information**

If you are a California resident, you have the right to request that we disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of your personal information.

- **Right to Request Deletion under CCPA**

California residents have the right to request that we delete any personal information that we have collected and retained from them, subject to certain exceptions. Upon receiving and verifying a verifiable CCPA request (see Exercising CCPA Rights below), we will delete (and direct our service providers to delete) the personal information from our databases, unless an exception applies.

- **Request for Correction under CCPA**

California residents have the right to request that we correct any inaccurate personal information that we collect or maintain about them, subject to certain exceptions.

We may deny your request for correction if (a) we believe that the personal information we maintain about you is accurate, (b) correcting the personal information would be impossible or involve disproportionate effort, or (c) the request is inconsistent with our legal obligations."

- **Right to Opt-Out of Sale and Disclosure of Personal Information**

California residents have the right to direct us not to 'sell' their personal information to third parties for monetary or other valuable consideration, and not to 'disclose' their personal information to third parties for cross-context behavioral advertising purposes.

Selling of information

We respect your privacy rights under the California Consumer Protection Act (CCPA). In accordance with the CPA, We do not sell your personal information that is collected under this Privacy Notice and do not use it for targeted advertising.

We are committed to protecting your data and ensuring that your personal information is used only for the purposes authorized by you. Only you or a legally authorized representative can submit a verifiable CCPA request regarding your personal information. To designate someone as a legally authorized representative, you may provide proof of authorization to the following address.

A verifiable CCPA request must provide sufficient information that allows us to reasonably verify that you are the person (or an authorized representative of such person) about whom we have collected personal information. This may include information that has already been provided to us, such as your name and email address. Additionally, the CCPA request should include enough detail to allow us to properly understand and respond to your request.

We will not be able to respond to your CCPA request or provide you with personal information if we are unable to verify your identity or authority to make the request and confirm that the personal information relates to you or the person on whose behalf you are

legally authorized to act. We will use the personal information provided in the verifiable CCPA request solely for the purpose of verifying identity or the right to make the request.

Changes to CCPA Information

We reserve the right to change this CCPA Information at our discretion and at any time. When we make changes to this Information, we will post the updated information in the Privacy Policy and update the effective date of the Information. Continued use of the services after any changes in the Information signifies acceptance of those changes.
